Travel Insurance

- This covers medical issues while traveling – which many standard medical insurance policies do not provide. Also covers things like lost bags, delays, cancelled flights, stolen gear, etc. (return)

Ground Search and Rescue in Utah

- Run by the county sheriff
- Air rescue starts at where the casualty is picked up and goes to a trailhead location accessible by ground ambulance
- Often employ volunteer rescuers
- Sheriff has the authority to call in professional rescue
- There is always a threat of a bill to the victim, and Wayne and Grand County Utah have billed individual victims thousands of dollars for rescue (return)

Air Search and Rescue in Utah

- Requested at sheriff's discretion
- Air rescue starts at where the casualty is picked up and goes to a trailhead location accessible by ground ambulance
- Classic Air Medical (base in Richfield) provides this as a community service up to 2 hours

- Intermountain Life Flight provides this as a community service and can perform lift hoist rescue in terrain that is inaccessible for helicopter landing
- Other agencies that operate in Utah include AirMed and AirLife Utah (return)

Air Medical Transport

- Starts at the trailhead as defined by insurance and proceeds to the nearest medical facility with the appropriate level of care
- This is generally a covered benefit for health insurance in the US but you need to check your policy (return)

Repatriation

- This is a complex topic and transport can be extremely expensive
- Within the US this is covered by insurance based on a determination of medical necessity
- You need to be very clear on coverage before you commit to a repatriation flight (return)

Utah Search and Rescue Assistance Card (USARA)

- This is not insurance it's a show of good faith for the community that you are paying in and there is an expectation that you won't be billed
- 1 year individual \$25

SelectHealth

- Standard medical insurance provide in Utah
- Provides policies by the day (return)
